October 12 by 5 p.m.

Voter registration deadline for the General Election.

October 17

Early voting begins.

October 30 by 5 p.m.

Last day to request an absentee ballot by mail.

November 3 at 1 p.m.

Early voting ends.

November 6

Election Day! Polls open 6:30 a.m. – 7:30 p.m.



Register to vote in Wake County if you are...

- A citizen of the United States
- 18 years of age or older by Election Day
- A legal resident of Wake County for at least 30 days before the next election
- Not a felon with an active sentence
