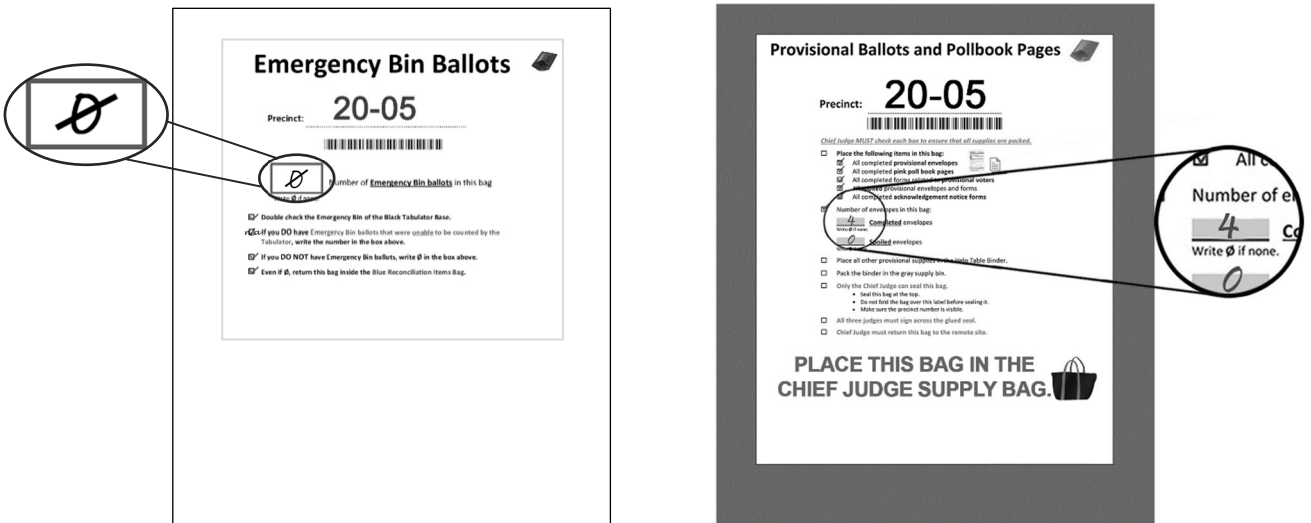

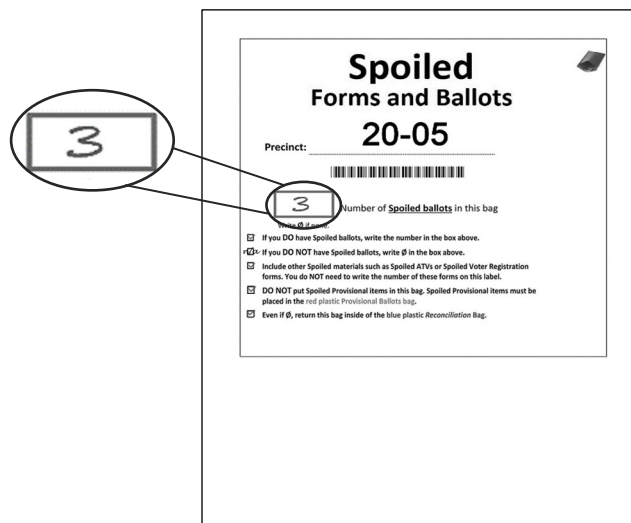

- There were no voter challenged ballots.
- There are no ballots abandoned in the voting booths, the curbside privacy sleeve, or the ExpressVote.
- Officials spoiled ATVs for any voters who decided not to vote, and the ATV numbers were reused. The ATVs are numbered correctly.

Reviewing ATVs: Answers

ATV Exercise 1: No

This voter was transferred to your precinct at 20-05 from precinct 20-02. Upon arriving they were sent to the Help Table. Sections C and D of the ATV were both completed correctly, the voter signed in Section A, and they were sent to the Ballot Table. However, this voter was not processed properly because the Ballot Table Official issued the wrong ballot style compared to what was written in sections C and D of the ATV.

ATV Exercise 2: No

This pollbook label has a HAVA ID designation because the first-time voter's registration form was incomplete or some of the information could not be verified. Since the voter was unable to provide a suitable form of HAVA ID at the Registration Table, your Official correctly marked the ATV to transfer the voter to the Help Table. However, since both the "HAVA ID shown" section and the signature/initials lines are blank, this voter should not have been issued a ballot. When being transferred from the Registration Table, this voter likely went to the Ballot Table instead of the Help Table like they were supposed to. This is just one of many reasons why having a clear setup inside your polling place is crucial!

ATV Exercise 3: Yes

This voter came in with a "V" on their pollbook label, indicating that the Board of Elections sent them mail that was returned as "Undeliverable". This voter also had a HAVA ID designation on their pollbook label. The voter was sent to the Help Table where the issues were resolved and then sent to the Ballot Table where they were successfully voted.

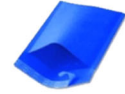
